

Caring for and protecting leather motorbike clothing

To increase the lifespan of your leather clothing, you should pay attention to regular and proper care!

Please always note the sewn-in care label!

- Before wearing your new leather garment for the first time, it should be waterproofed. This protects it from wet spots and ensures that it absorbs less dirt.
- After use, hang the garments so that they can air out well.
- Dry your wet leather garments by hanging them or lying them down at room temperature. Do not put them on the heater. Avoid direct sunlight. Otherwise the leather can dry out or fade. We recommend "kneading" the garment after drying to make the leather supple again.
- Clean your soiled smooth leather with a textile cloth or sponge. Please use only clear water or special cleaning agents from our range (e.g. S100 leather cleaner).
Do not use harsh solvents such as petrol, nitro thinner or turpentine!
- Rub the leather dry with a towel. Afterwards, you should care for your garment with a special leather grease or oil. Even after cleaning, we recommend that you reapply a waterproofing spray, e.g. the S100 Waterproofing Spray.
- Suede leather (nubuck, velour) is not greased, but only wet cleaned in exceptional cases. Brush dirt out dry. You can roughen bare spots with a special brush.
- With nubuck and velour garments, avoid light-coloured sofas, textiles and similarly sensitive surfaces for the first while, as the residues of the sanding dust will only disappear when worn.
Note: Leather can stain in general - e.g. as a reaction to sweat, but also when the leather is dry!
- Heavily soiled leather garments should always be treated by a leather cleaning specialist.

Care tips

The right care is also a prerequisite for enjoying your clothing for a long time. This overview of the important care symbols should help you. You can find them on the labels of the respective items.

Bleaching



Chlorine and oxygen bleaching permissible



Only oxygen bleach permissible; no chlorine bleach

Ironing



hot iron (level 3)



iron moderately hot (level 2)



do not iron hot (level 1)

The dots indicate the temperature ranges of the iron.

Washing



Normal wash cycle



hand wash only at max. 30°C



Gentle wash cycle



do not wash

The degree numbers correspond to the maximum washing temperatures - these must not be exceeded. Some materials require gentle mechanical treatment.
